

## Neustar Names Scott Blake Harris as EVP Legal and External Affairs

served in government from 1993 to 1996, first as Chief Counsel for Export Administration in the

United States Department of Commerce, and then as the first Chief of the International Bureau



at the Federal Communications Commission. Early in his career he served as a law clerk to the

Honorable Gerhard A. Gesell on the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

He is a magna cum laude graduate of both Harvard Law School and Brown University.
