

Over 400 Roanoke County Students Honored For Completing Neustar's Digital Responsibility Program

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Hidden Valley High School Receives \$1,000 Neustar Technology Grant to Support Technology Initiatives

Today, Roanoke County Public Schools recognized more than 400 graduates from Neustar's [My Digital Life](#) program, a digital education course designed to empower young people to be responsible technology users. The Center for Digital Education recently named Roanoke County Public Schools as one of the top digital Districts in the country. The school board’s 1:1 laptop initiative has provided students with access to industry-standard software for internships, online courses for dual-enrollment students, and real-time data and assessments, in addition to advanced technologies in the classroom such as drones equipped with HD cameras, robotics, and blueprint design tools and 3D printers. Since the program’s inception, over 12,000 students across Virginia have completed Neustar’s *My Digital Life* learning program.
